On November 19, 2009 Secretary of Labor Hilda Solis announced the hiring of an additional 250 wage and hour investigators, as well as a public awareness campaign to inform workers about their rights entitled "We Can Help." In addition to anticipated stepped-up enforcement of the wage and hour laws, wage and hour violations have become more costly for employers and offer attorneys representing employees the prospect of larger damage awards as collective and class actions for wage and hour violations are becoming more common. In-house counsel, human resource professionals and attorneys working in the area of employment and labor law need to be familiar with identifying potential wage and hour compliance issues, what to expect in litigating wage and hour issues, and current trends in wage and hour litigation.
